

LITTLE HOUSE ON THE PRAIRIE



1890 (ONE YEAR LATER) THE CREATION

- THE OKLAHOMA TERRITORIAL NORMAL SCHOOL ACT WAS CREATED AND PASSED DECEMBER 23, 1890.
- SIGNED INTO LAW DECEMBER 24, 1890.
- JUNE 1892....THE NORMAL SCHOOL (TEACHERS SCHOOL) IS THE FIRST HIGHER EDUCATION BUILDING ERECTED IN THE OKLAHOMA TERRITORY.
 - OU WAS SEPTEMBER 3, 1893
 - OSU WAS JUNE 15, 1894.

BIRTH

CONDITIONS OF THE ANTON CLASSEN ACT REQUIRED THAT LAND MUST BE DONATED AND THE CITY PASS A BOND ISSUE

GAIL WHITELY PROVIDED THE ORIGINAL DESIGN CONCEPT IN 1892

- DONATED 40 ACRES
- EDMOND BOND ISSUE \$2,000
- OKLAHOMA COUNTY BOND ISSUE \$5,000
- SALE OF LOTS NEAR CAMPUS \$3,500

BIRMH

- KANSAS FIRM OF SPICKNALL, TOWNSEND AND HUBBARD BEGAN WORK SUMMER 1892.
- DURING CONSTRUCTION, CLASSES WERE HELD IN UNFINISHED PORTIONS OF THE BUILDING
 - (EVEN THEN F/S HAD TO DEAL WITH IT)
- CLASSES BEGAN JANUARY 2, 1893. INITIAL CONSTRUCTION CONTINUED THRU 1894
- DURING THE FIRST YEAR, NO INTERIOR FINISHES OR HEAT

BIRTH

- INITIAL RECTANGULAR HIP ROOF BUILDING CONTAINED FOUR ROOMS AND AN ASSEMBLY HALL ON THE TWO FLOORS
- AUGUST 1893, JOHN L. MITCH PLANTS 1,000 TREES ON THE NORMAL GROUNDS AND IS CALLED "FATHER OF THE NORMAL SCHOOL"


REBIORME

1893 A LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE APPROVES A \$15,000 APPROPRIATION FOR CONSTRUCTION OF A TOWER AND WINGS

JG HASKELL (OF BACK EAST) IS SELECTED ARCHITECT

JANUARY 1894 EXCAVATION
BEGINS & RYAN CONSTRUCTION
HIRED TO COMPLETE WORK

1893 UNDER CONSTRUCTION



BIRTH PAINS

- 1898 THE CENTER SECTION WAS STILL ORIGINAL BRICK WITH ARCHED WINDOWS
- LATE 1899 THE CENTER SECTION WAS MODIFIED FOR SANDSTONE VENEER
- THE TROUBLES WERE JUST STARTING

REBURTH

- LOCAL SANDSTONE IS SELECTED AND QUARRIED FROM LAND OWNED BY LB POTTS. (SAME STONE USED IN 2002)
- JULY 20, 1894 REGENTS MEET AND OFFICIALLY OCCUPY THE NORTH WING OF THE BUILDING.
- EXTERIOR IS COMPLETE BUT INTERIOR IS UNFINISHED AND THE SOUTH WING IS NOT COMPLETED UNTIL 1896 (STILL PARTIAL EVEN THEN)





BIRTH PAINS

- CLASSES HAD BEEN HELD IN THE BUILDING SINCE JANUARY 2, 1893 WITHOUT HEAT OR ELECTRICITY
- JULY 1895 CONTRACT AWARDED TO INSTALL HEAT
- 1896 THE SOUTH WING WAS STILL UNDER CONSTRUCTION
- JANUARY 1898 THE NORTH WING WAS FULLY OCCUPIED AND THE SOUTH WING THREE FLOORS WERE COMPLETED

GROWTH PAINS

- LATE 1899 THE TOP FLOOR NORTH WING IS MADE INTO CLASSROOMS AND DORMERS ARE ADDED FOR LIGHT AND AIR FLOW (HOT IN OKLAHOMA AND TUCSON)
- 1899 GAS LIGHTING SYSTEM INSTALLED AND CANDLES ARE REMOVED AFTER SMALL FIRE
- WORK CONTINUES ON THE FOURTH FLOOR SOUTH WING



GROWTH PAINS

- 1902 FOURTH FLOOR SOUTH WING COMPLETED AND FOUR CLASSROOMS ADDED
- ATTIC REMAINS ABOVE CENTER SECTION
- 1903 ELECTRIC LIGHTS AND FIRE WATER LINES ADDED (NO INTERIOR PLUMBING)
- 1905 COAL HEATING INSTALLED AND FIRE PLACES REMOVED

GROWTH PAINS

■ 1905 PORTICO'S ADDED TO NORTH AND SOUTH ENTRY'S TO CONTROL WIND (REALLY WINDY IN OKLAHOMA), COLD AND HOT.



AGONY

1911 PLANS WERE MADE TO DEMOLISH OLD NORTH DUE TO DILAPIDATED, UNSAFE AND UNSANITARY CONDITIONS (CIVILIZATION HAD ARRIVED IN OKLAHOMA)

WIDER WINDOWS, A GYMNASTICS
ROOM IN BASEMENT (FORMER

ECSTASY

IN ADDITION, WOOD SHINGLE ROOF REPLACED WITH MODERN STAMPED METAL, A FACELIFT OF THE EAST AND WEST FAÇADE'S ARE REDONE BY ADDING ADDITIONAL SANDSTONE VENEER TO MATCH THE TOWER AND INTERIOR STRUCTURAL REPAIRS ARE PERFORMED, INCLUDING CONCRETE COLUMNS AND CONCRETE LINTELS TO FIX BROKEN STONE LINTELS ON THE EAST AND WEST TO "MODERNIZE" THE BUILDING.



NORMAL AT NORMAL

- 1911 THE ENTRY VESTIBULES ARE REMOVED
- 1912 CLOCK AND CHIMES ADDED
- 1912 FIRE STAIR ADDED FROM FOURTH FLOOR SOUTH TO SERVE AS ACCESS TO FOURTH FLOOR (INTERIOR STAIR ONLY WENT TO THE THIRD FLOOR)
- INTERIOR CHANGES IN THE FOURTH FLOOR ATTIC CONTINUED.

1918

REALLY NOT NORMAL

IN ORDER TO MAKE ROOM IN THE ATTIC, ALL ORIGINAL BRIDGE TRUSSES WERE CUT, BOTTOM CORDS TIED TO TOP CORDS WITH WOOD, BOTTOM CORDS HELD UP BY CEILING STRUCTURE AND THE NEW FLOOR SUPPORTED BY THE CEILING STRUCTURE AND HUNG FROM THE TOP CORDS





- 1936 OLD NORTH CONDEMNED AGAIN
- DILAPIDATED CONDITIONS
- OVERCROWDING
- UNSAFE CONDITIONS AND FIRE HAZARDS





1950'S

POSTCARD PERFECT?

IF YOU CAN IGNORE REALITY

- 1936 TO 1950 LIEB CONTUNUES
- OLD NORTH CONTINUES TO STAND
- MORE AND MORE PUT IN IT
- LESS AND LESS CONCERN FOR HOW MUCH IT WILL HOLD

LIFE GOES ON

- 1953 OLD NORTH UNDERGOES EXTENSIVE RENOVATION AND AIR CONDITIONING INSTALLED
- 1953 THE OLD FOURTH FLOOR ATTIC, LONG ABANDONED (REMEMBER 1936?) DUE TO "RICKETY CONDITIONS UNSAFE FOR OCCUPANCY" IS REMODELED FOR USE BY DEVELOPMENT AND PUBLIC INFORMATION OFFICES.

SOMBUNDS

- NO STRUCTURAL WORK WAS DONE TO ACCOMMODATE THIS NEW LOADING
 - GUESS THE PR FOLKS WERE EXPENDABLE?
- NOTE SAID SOME "STOP GAP"
 MEASURES WERE TAKEN

AND ON

- 1955 THE FOURTH FLOOR WAS REMODELED FOR CLASSROOMS. NEW ELEVATOR AND STRUCTURE FOR ELEVATOR ADDED
- NO OTHER STRUCTURAL WORK PERFORMED
- 1955 NEW DORMERS ADDED
- 1955 THE REPLACEMENT TRUSS (REMEMBER 1918?) WAS CUT AND REMOVED AND THE DORMER CARRIED THE ROOF LOAD

DISCOVERY

1911 WOOD COLUMNS ADDED TO TOP OF EXISTING CONCRETE COLUMNS (ONLY EXTENDED TO BELOW ATTIC FLOOR) TO HELP SUPPORT THE ROOF LOAD

1955-1972 SAW MANY UNWISE CHANGES AND MODIFICATIONS, INSTALLATION OF DUCT WORK, ELECTRICAL WIRING, NEW PARTITIONS, NEW TOILETS, SUSPENDED CEILINGS, ETC. ALL OF WHICH LEAD TO CONTINUED STRUCTURAL FAILURE BY REMOVAL OF LOAD BEARING WALLS.

NOVEMBER 9, 1972 OLD NORTH ADDED TO NATIONAL HISTORIC REGISTER AS HISTORIC SITE

MORE DISCOVERY

- 1972 TO 1977 MORE INTERIOR RENOVATIONS, REMOVAL OF NARROW WOOD STAIR AND INSTALLATION OF NEW CONCRETE STAIR, INCLUDING STAIR TO FOURTH FLOOR SOUTH WING. MODERN ALUMINUM WINDOWS INSTALLED AND WOODEN WINDOW FRAMING ON FOURTH FLOOR EAST DORMER IS REMOVED (REMEMBER THE PART ABOUT HOLDING THE ROOF UP?)
- ALUMINUM WINDOWS AT EAST DORMER ARE ONLY VISIBLE MEANS OF SUPPORT FOR ROOF LOAD (REALLY GOOD ALUMINUM)



STAYS BAD, BUT HEY

- 1972 TO 1992 THINGS GOT WORSE BUT NO ONE COMPLAINED SO HEY....BUT FINALLY!
- 1993 GENERAL OBLIGATION BOND
 - OLD NORTH ADDED FOR RESTORATION
 - UCO FUNDING PULLED
 - OLD NORTH CONTINUED IN USE

- 1996 REVENUE BOND GIVES OLD NORTH ANOTHER CHANCE
- \$1,500,000 AVAILABLE FOR EXTERIOR RESTORATION
- NOVEMBER 1999 DESIGNS STARTED

HORIDE WANTED

- NOVEMBER 1999 MILES ASSOCIATES HIRED
- HISTORIC STRUCTURES REPORT AUTHORIZED
- STRUCTURAL ANALYSIS AUTHORIZED

WE'RE OFF!

- 2000 MID CONTINENTAL RESTORATION AWARDED CONTRACT FOR PHASE I
- 2000-2001 MAJOR EXTERIOR REPAIRS, STONE CONSOLIDATION, FOUNDATIONS, TUCKPOINTING (100%), STRUCTURAL TIES TO STABILIZE CLOCK TOWER (BANANA PEEL)
- STRUCTURAL STABILIZATION FROM 1912 FIRE STAIR, TOTAL WINDOW REPLACEMENT, ETC.

- JULY 2001 THE PROBLEM IS SIMPLY TOO BIG TO IGNORE


REALLY BAD







THE AMAZING....HUH?



- For what it's worth...
 Aluminum windows above
 - Removed truss below
 - Removed truss below
 - Elevator structure with push me pull you
 - Tension/compression in wood





MOMOBIO REPUBLICAN

- 2001-2002 MAJOR INTERIOR STRUCTURAL REPAIRS MANDATED. REMOVAL OF FOURTH FLOOR ATTIC PROPOSED, HOWEVER, STRUCTURAL ENGINEERS BELIEVE BUILDING WILL COLLAPSE IF DONE AT THAT TIME
- ROOF OVER CENTER SECTION REMOVED AND REPLACED
- FOURTH FLOOR ATTIC SHORED FROM BELOW AND REMAINS FOR REMOVAL IN PHASE II (WE HOPE)





AND WHONK

- NEW TRUSSES REQUIRED, MAJOR DEMOLITION OF SECOND AND THIRD FLOOR MANDATED
- ALL ELECTRICAL SYSTEMS OFF LINE
- ALL HVAC SYSTEMS OFF LINE
- BUILDING IS IN LIMBO
- COSTS ESCALATE TO \$2,000,000

AND LIFE GOES ON

- **2005** GENERAL BOND ISSUE
- OLD NORTH FUNDED FOR \$5,000,000 FOR PHASE I INTERIORS
- BOND FUNDS HELD PENDING LITIGATION
- PLANNING TO START JANUARY
 2006

ARCHUBCIS ROLE?

- 1970-1990 SEVERAL MAJOR A/E FIRMS PREPARED RENOVATION DOCUMENTS
- NO ONE LOOKED AT THE BUILDING AS A WHOLE
- ONLY DEALT WITH "THEIR"
 PIECE

WHO'S RESPONSIBLE?

- NO ONE LOOKED OUTSIDE THEIR BOX
- FEES WERE TOO LOW
- **ASSUMED OTHERS KNEW**
- BUDGETS WERE TOO TIGHT
