

...Due to the Tabor, Gallagher and Amendment 23 Problems





CU Contributes to Colorado's Economy

- For Each \$1 in State General Fund Support, \$1.01 is Recaptured by CO in Taxes
- For Each \$1 in State General Fund Support, CU Adds \$16.64 to the CO economy
 - One of the highest rates of return for any state university nationally
- CU Students Spent More Than \$742M in CO
- Fitzsimons Redevelopment Expected to Generate More than 23,000 Jobs (indirect and induced)




Birthplace of The Transitional Trans-Gendered Restroom
